## **BJC BLS Instructor Renewal Requirements**

Instructors may renew their status by either:

- A. Meeting all of the following criteria below (#1-6)
- B. Attending an instructor renewal class
- 1. **Demonstrate** acceptable **provider skills**.
  - a. Successful completion of skills must be documented on the BLS Skills Checklists.
- 2. Earn 4 credits by doing any combination of the following:
  - a. **Teach** a minimum of **4 classroom provider courses or provider updates or renewals** in 2 years for the discipline in which the instructor is renewing.
  - b. Conduct skills practice and testing sessions for eLearning courses.
    Each day of skills practice and testing sessions counts as 1 of the required 4 courses; all 4 credits can be earned this way.
  - c. Attend update session as required within the previous 2 years. Updates may address new course content or methodology and review TC, regional, and national ECC information.
- 3. Be monitored while teaching before instructor status expiration.
  - a. The first monitoring after the initial instructor course does not satisfy this requirement.
  - b. Training Center Faculty (TCF) or Regional Faculty (RF) must perform monitoring session.
- 4. **Pass written Provider test** with 84% or greater score.
- 5. Complete "Instructor/TCF Renewal Checklist".
- 6. **Proof of current**, not expired, **BLS Instructor Card**.

A new provider card may be issued at the discretion of the TC or on request of the renewing instructor but is not required by the AHA.

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
