

BJC HealthCare's Campus Renewal, a partnership of Barnes-Jewish Hospital (BJH), St. Louis Children's Hospital (SLCH) and Washington University School of Medicine, is a project to renew the Washington University Medical Campus. Launched in 2012, the project is transforming the campus through new construction and renovations, creating an environment and experience that matches the excellent care patients receive. Private rooms are a key component, along with major improvements to open and public areas, and to patient and visitor arrival and departure. The project is being completed in four phases:

#### **CURRENT - PHASE 3-4**

Barnes-Jewish Hospital Tower

- Expands heart and vascular clinical care, cardiothoracic and cardiac intensive care units
- Creates state-of-the-art surgical prep and recovery
- Modernizes imaging platform
- Provides for modern dietary program and new public cafeteria
- Adds outdoor rooftop gardens and respite spaces; family accommodations
- Enhances arrival experience with clear destinations for parking and drop-off, and a renovated and expanded lobby

### 2018-2021 - PHASE 2 • COMPLETE

#### Barnes-Jewish Hospital and St. Louis Children's Hospital

- Renovated three floors in East/West Pavilions vacated during Phase 1
- Renovated radiology in Shoenberg Pavilion
- Renovated SLCH pediatric intensive care unit and newborn intensive care unit
- Replaced and expanded the electrical substation; extensive electrical infrastructure upgrades
- Demolished Queeny Tower

### 2013-2018 - PHASE 1 • COMPLETE

Barnes-Jewish Hospital Parkview Tower

- Consolidated and expanded oncology and surgical services
- Modernized and expanded the Women & Infants program and co-located with SLCH newborn intensive care unit (NICU)
- Added outdoor rooftop gardens

### St. Louis Children's Hospital expansion

- Expanded the NICU, co-located with BJH labor and delivery
- Expanded inpatient beds
- Expanded diagnostics and outpatient clinics
- A second outdoor rooftop garden and therapy space
